



Hotel Sacher Wien is No. 42 in The 50 Best Hotels

Hotel Sacher Wien once again ranks among the world's best hotels, taking No. 42

Vienna, September 15, 2026 – The family-run 5-star-superior Hotel Sacher Wien has been named one of the world's best hotels for the second consecutive year. At the announcement of the internationally renowned The 50 Best Hotels 2026 ranking, the hotel secured No. 42 moving further up the list. In the year of its 150th anniversary, this recognition holds particular significance.

Sacher is the only hotel in Austria to receive this distinction and, together with Badrutt's Palace Hotel in Switzerland, one of only two hotels in the German-speaking region to be included in the ranking.

The ranking was announced on 15 September during an international live countdown in Paris, where representatives of Hotel Sacher Wien accepted the recognition in person. The 50 Best Hotels was first published in 2023 and recognises outstanding hotel experiences around the world. The ranking is based on the votes of the 50 Best Hotels Academy, comprising more than 800 independent international experts, including hoteliers, travel journalists and experienced luxury travellers.
